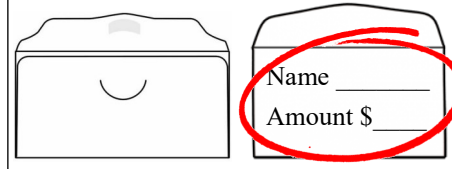

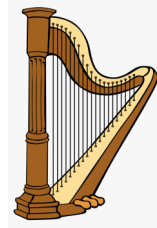
Parent & Child Dedication

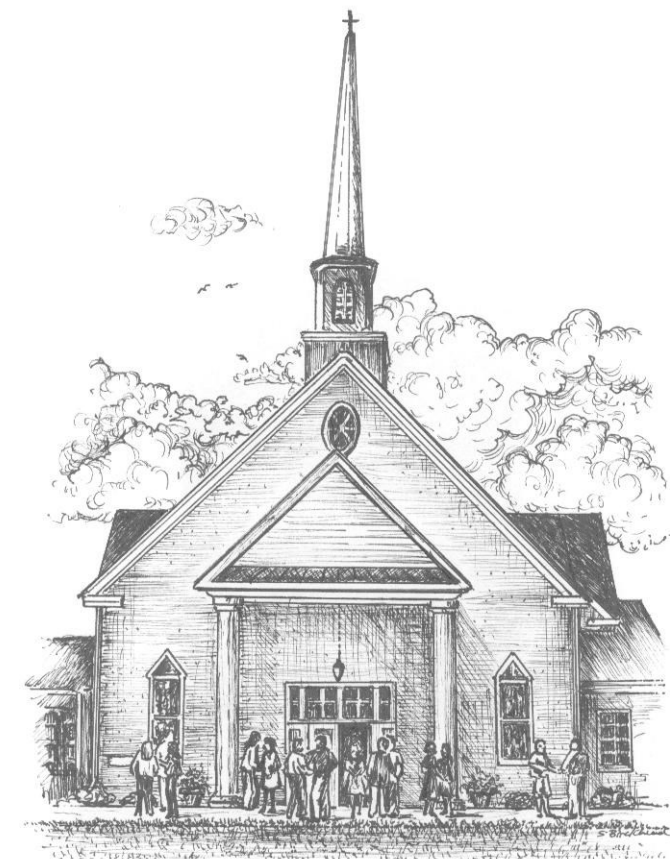
