Jesus said..., "25 I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

John 11:25-26

Jesus communicated these words to Martha after the death of her brother Lazarus, who was one of Jesus' closest friends. He encouraged Martha in her sorrow by

assuring her, "your brother will rise again" (John 11:23). Martha misunderstood Jesus to be explaining how everyone will be raised from the dead at the end time. Martha said to Jesus, I know that he will be raised from the dead. However, Jesus had something more immediate in mind. Do you believe this? What a great question. Martyn Lloyd-Jones, a Welsh minister, often said Christianity is about good questions. Here is why: it is easy to misunderstand things in the Bible. We should straighten our question marks into exclamation marks of belief. So do you believe that Jesus is the resurrection and the life? I am certain you do.

The supernatural resurrection of Jesus from the dead, which we celebrate at Easter, is one of several major doctrines of our Christian faith. Hebrews 10:20 tells us that Jesus made a "new and living" way out from the old and into the new. This month let me remind you and your family to "walk in the newness of life" in Jesus (Romans 6:4).

This month as Spring begins to freshen the air here in Northeast North Carolina, I look forward to all of the activities and ministries of Rocky Hock Baptist. Why? Ever since I became your pastor in August 2019, I have been unable to enjoy a "normal" April due to COVID-19. I am excited for our children and families to come together on the 2nd of April to experience our annual Egg Drop which begins at 11:30 AM. Then, Sunday, April 10th we will celebrate the Lord's Supper in the Morning Worship Service. I am looking forward with expectation to our Easter Drama and Musical held on Friday, April 15th and Saturday, April 16th at 7 PM in the sanctuary.
