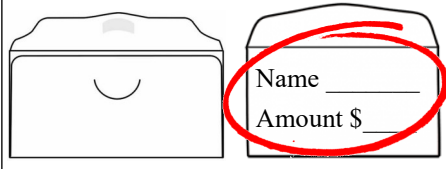
Summer Camps

The Personnel Committee, in collaboration with the Deacons, Student Ministries Team and Children's Ministries Team, recommend that a full-time Youth Pastor and a part-time Children's Director be hired to minister to our youth and children. The positions will allow one director to primarily minister to our children (up through grade 5) and another minister would concentrate on students from the 6th grade through college and early working years.

In the vestibule, you will find copies of the recommended job descriptions for the **Associate Pastor of Student Ministries** and **Director of Family and Children's Ministries**. A Question & Answer Session will be held on May 11, 2022. Please review these job descriptions, as it will be brought up for a vote on May 15, 2022 after Morning Worship at a special called Church Conference.

These job descriptions come from the Personnel Committee, where they were developed in cooperation with the Student Ministries Team, the Youth Pastor Search Committee, the Children's Ministries Team and the Deacons. Approval of these job descriptions will enable the Youth Pastor Search Committee to post our open position for Associate Pastor of Student Ministries and actually begin its task of finding a new pastor to fill this position.

Before seeking a Director of Family and Children's Ministries, the Finance Team and the Deacons will establish a salary and a Search Committee will need to be selected. That work will occur in the near future.

By voting to approve the job descriptions for the Associate Pastor of Student Ministries and Director of Family and Children's Ministries, you are also voting to separate the positions and responsibilities.

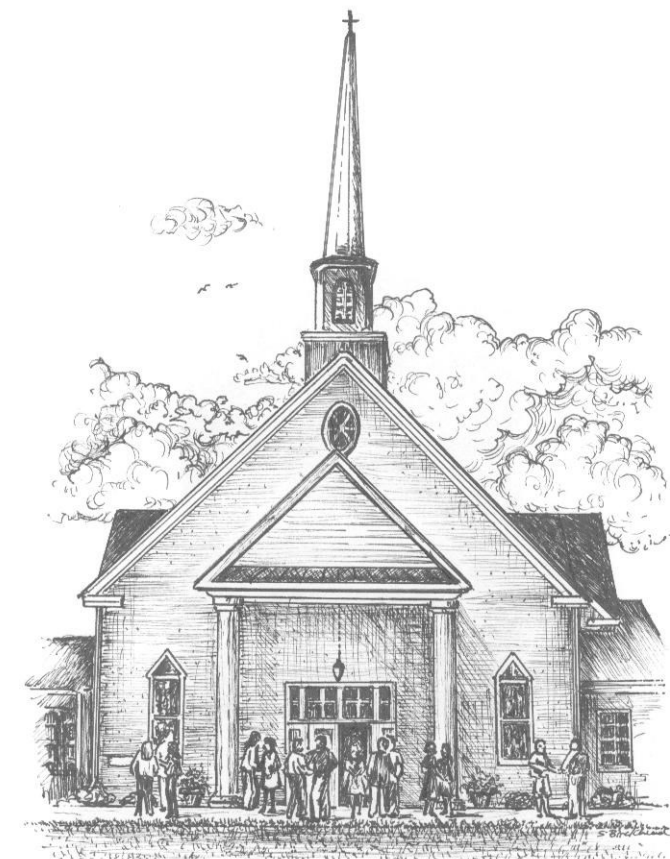
