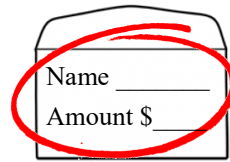

Rocky Hock Church Family,

As most of you know, this school year I have been blessed to live in Vienna, Austria while teaching at the International Christian School of Vienna. Our school is a non-denominational, Christian school which offers instruction in English, and, being a private school, offers every student Bible classes, and chapel on a regular basis.

This year has been an incredible opportunity for me to grow professionally, and as a Christian. While a Christian school, ICSV serves nearly 400 students from more than 65 countries, many of whom come from different faith backgrounds. As such, it is an incredible mission field each and every day.

While COVID has caused problems throughout the school year, we were really thrown a curve ball in February when Russia invaded Ukraine. School officials all over Europe, including here in Vienna, began preparing for the coming influx of refugee students. International schools in particular were asked by European governments to do as much as possible for these children, as we are better prepared to deal with non-native speakers than public schools. Since the war in Ukraine began, ICSV has been able to accommodate a number of Ukrainian students into our regular classes and has also set up a refugee-run tutoring center for Ukrainian students who have relocated to Vienna but are still completing their schooling online through their schools in Ukraine.

We are happy to offer the refugee students tuition waivers where possible, but the Ukrainian crisis has put a strain on our school's finances. While the school year is rapidly coming to an end, it unfortunately appears that this situation will continue into the 2022 - 2023 school year as well. If you are looking for a way to help many of the Ukrainians who have relocated to Vienna, please consider donating to ICSV if you are able. 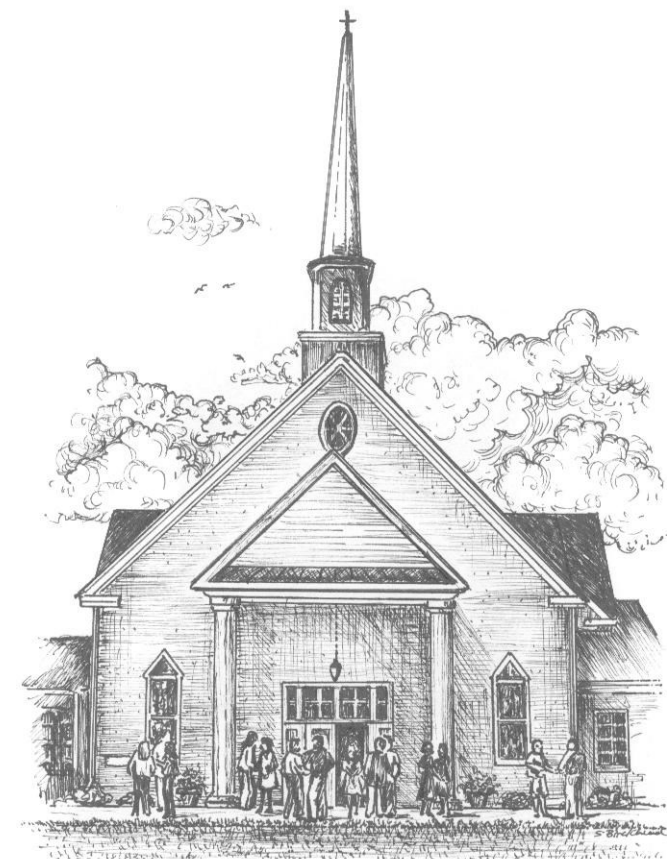
