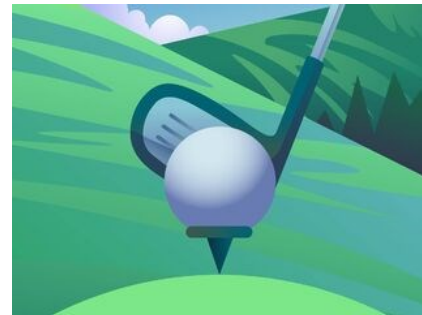

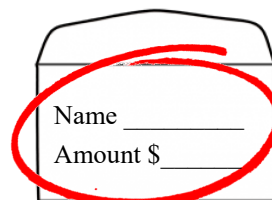

VOTE ON INTERIM SENIOR PASTOR

The Deacons move that Rocky Hock Baptist Church call Pastor Bob Young as our Interim Senior Pastor effective September 4, 2022, until such time as we have a new full-time Senior Pastor. Pastor Young will be paid at the rate of \$1,150 per week for his duties as Interim Pastor, along with mileage as appropriate. He will lead us in both services on Sunday and in Adult Bible Study on Wednesday night. He will be available in the church office one day each week and will do hospital visitation as needed, with any follow-up required. He will conduct funerals if requested and will perform weddings in the church if requested, after satisfactory counseling with the couple.

This motion will be voted on at a special called Church Conference after Morning Worship on Sunday, August 7th.

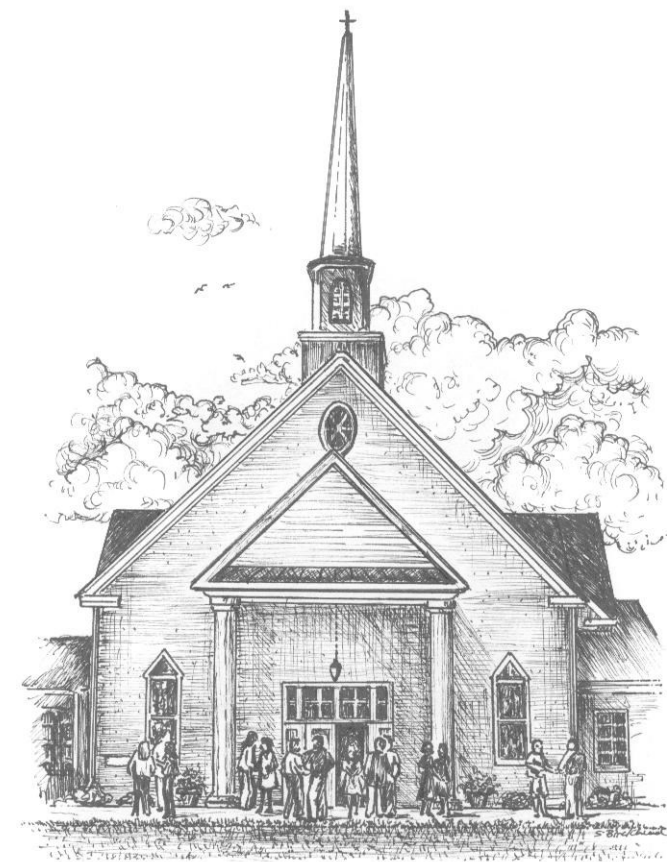
