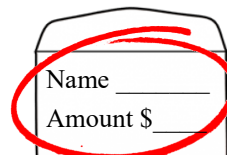


Upcoming Guest Speakers

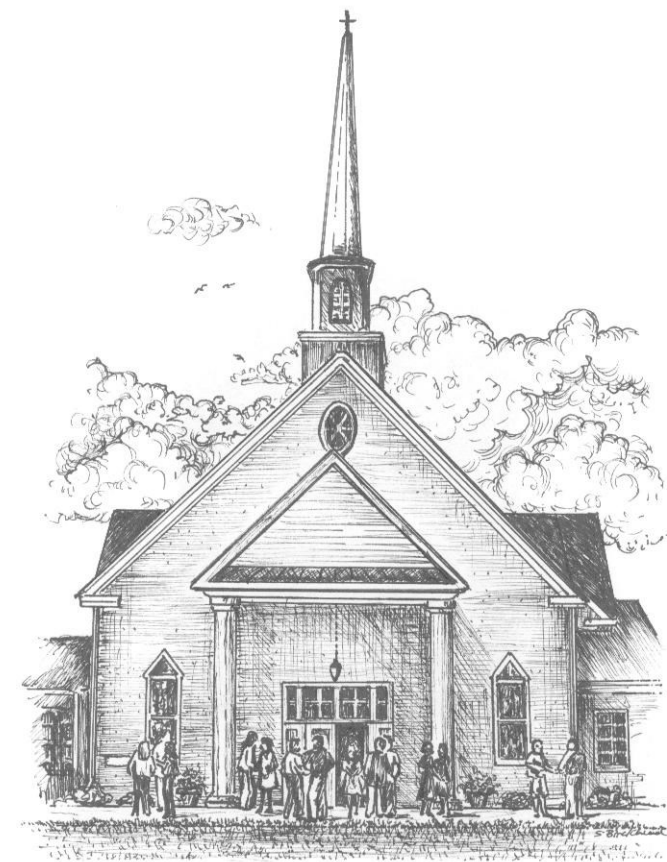
