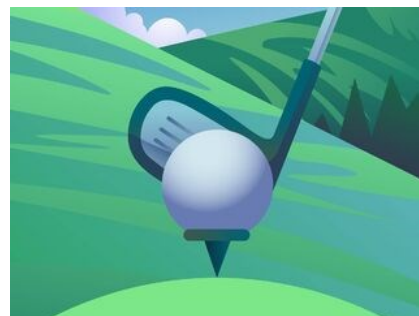

The following members were approved at the called Church Conference on Sunday, July 17th to serve as the Senior Pastor Search Committee: **Adam Bunch, Carroll Evans (Vice Chair), J.C. Forehand, Susan Nixon, Susan Sykes (Secretary), Ellis Tynch (Chair) and Chelsea White.**

VOTE ON INTERIM SENIOR PASTOR - The Deacons move that Rocky Hock Baptist Church call Pastor Bob Young as our Interim Senior Pastor effective September 4, 2022, until such time as we have a new full-time Senior Pastor. Pastor Young will be paid at the rate of \$1,150 per week for his duties as Interim Pastor, along with mileage as appropriate. He will lead us in both services on Sunday and in Adult Bible Study on Wednesday night. He will be available in the church office one day a week and will do hospital visitation as needed, with any follow-up required. He will conduct funerals and perform weddings in the church if requested, after satisfactory counseling with the couple. This motion will be voted on at a special called Church Conference after Morning Worship on Sunday, August 7th.

On August 14th at the 11 AM Worship Service, we will welcome Ms. Brenda Gray and residents from the Cameron Boys Camp for our **NC Baptist Children's Homes Sunday**. At that time, we will present them with the proceeds from our 14th Annual RHBC Golf Tournament.

Region 1 Mission Rally - On Tuesday, August 23, Baptists on Mission will host the Region 1 Mission Rally at Askewville Baptist Church in Windsor, NC. The rally will highlight the variety of opportunities NC Baptists have to be involved in missions. There will be worship, short testimonies, mission videos, and a prayer time for missions. A main focus of this rally will be state, national, international mission opportunities (including Disaster Relief), and the NC Missions Offering. A meal will be provided at no charge, but reservations are necessary to ensure an accurate meal count. The meal will begin at 5:45 PM followed by the program from 6:50 – 8:30 PM. The deadline for reserving a meal is August 16. Call the church office before that date if you would like to attend. We will then make reservations for all attendees from RHBC. You do not need a reservation to attend just the program following the meal.

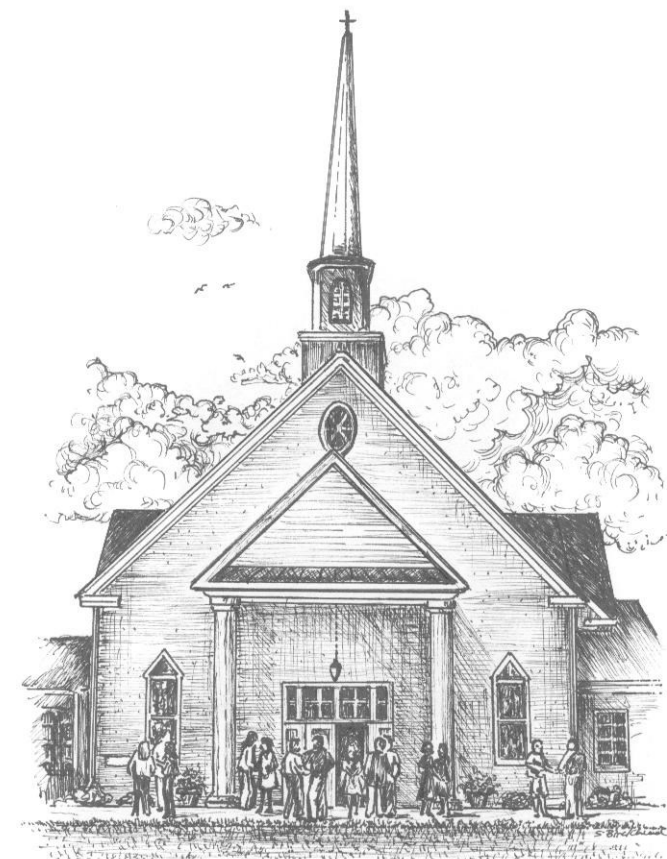
