Sunday, September 11th is designated for the North Carolina Missions Offering, supporting the ministries of Baptists on Mission, Church Planting, mission camps, associational projects and mobilization ministry projects. The theme for 2022 is "Relief for Today. Hope for Tomorrow" and RHBC's goal is \$6,000.

Today we welcome Ms. Brenda Gray and residents from the Duncan Girls Camp for our **NC Baptist Children's Homes Sunday.**

Rev. Bob Young has been approved as our Interim Senior Pastor effective September 4, 2022, until such time as we have a new full-time Senior Pastor. Rev. Young will be paid at the rate of \$1,150 per week for his duties as Interim Pastor, along with mileage as appropriate. He will lead us in both services on Sunday and in Adult Bible Study on Wednesday night. He will be available in the church office one day a week and will do hospital visitation as needed, with any follow-up required. He will conduct funerals and perform weddings in the church if requested, after satisfactory counseling with the couple.

Region 1 Mission Rally - On Tuesday, August 23, Baptists on Mission will host the Region 1 Mission Rally at Askewville Baptist Church in Windsor, NC. The rally will highlight the variety of opportunities NC Baptists have to be involved in missions. There will be worship, short testimonies, mission videos, and a prayer time for missions. A main focus of this rally will be state, national, international mission opportunities (including Disaster Relief), and the NC Missions Offering. A meal will be provided at no charge, but reservations are necessary to ensure an accurate meal count. The meal will begin at 5:45 PM followed by the program from 6:50 - 8:30 PM. **The deadline for reserving a meal is August 16th.** Call the church office before that date if you would like to attend. We will then make reservations for all attendees from RHBC. You do not need a reservation to attend just the program following the meal.

On Wednesday, August 24th @ 6:30 PM join us for a **Meal & Quarterly Church Conference.** Everyone will meet in the Gym. **If you are planning to attend, please complete a connection card** in the pew rack and place it in the offering plate so we will have an accurate count of how many meals to prepare.

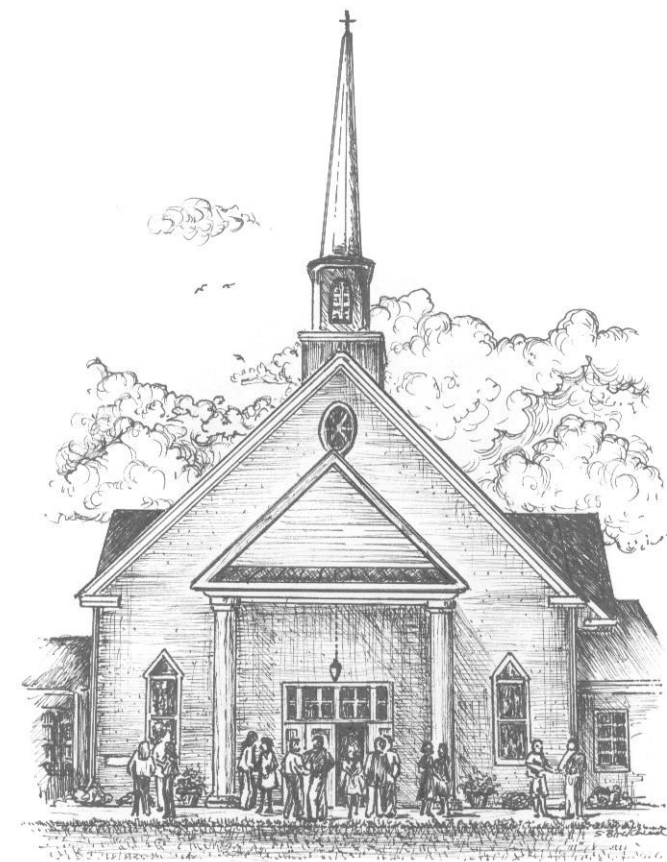
