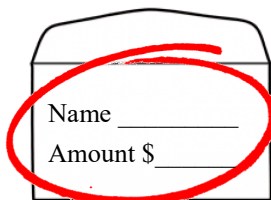
BUILDING FUND

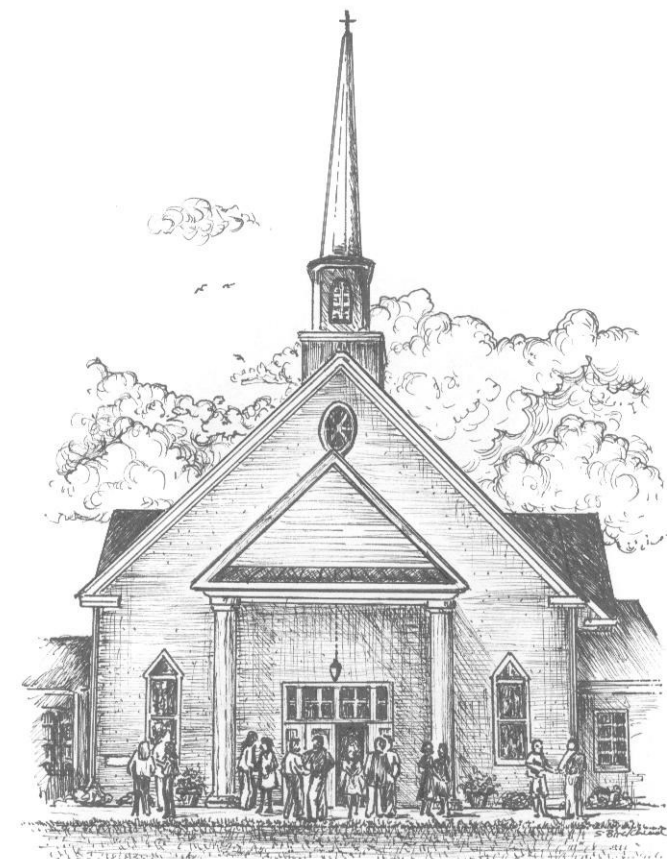
