"So teach us to number our days, That we may gain a heart of wisdom." ~ Psalm 90:12

Autumn will soon blow by us like an October breeze. But before it does, here are a few things you can fall into this month . . .

- October 9 We will share the Lord's Supper together in worship. It is also the Sunday for the World Hunger/Baptist Children's Home Offering. Then, in the evening, the Mile Post 13 Band from Nags Head Church will be leading a night of worship here at Rocky Hock.
- October 18 The Chowan Baptist Association annual meeting will be held right across the creek at Macedonia Baptist Church. You must be an elected messenger of your church to vote, but anybody can attend and discover what Chowan Baptists are doing together.

There are opportunities for worship, for giving, for connecting with fellow Baptists, and for outreach.

Moses asked God to help him number his days. Moses meant more than counting. He meant something like taking the measure of our days or understanding their significance. It is the prayer of a man who knows that he is not staying here and that the measure of his days on earth matters in eternity.

The almanac will quickly teach us the physical measure of a day. By October 31, the daylight will have diminished by nearly four hours from summer's peak. Yet the day will not have diminished at all. Everyone's day has the same number of hours. The true measure of a day is what we do with them.

And they slip away so easily, don't they? Indeed, the Bible says the whole world is passing away (1 John 2:17). Or listen to Isaiah . . .

"All the host of heaven shall rot away, and the skies roll up like a scroll. All their host shall fall, as leaves fall from the vine, like leaves falling from the fig tree." \sim Isaiah 34:4

Do you watch the falling leaves of autumn? They tumble. They swirl. They even sashay on a light breeze. Very soon now we will hear the rustle of their dry cloaks chaffing one another as they dance on the highway behind our speeding cars. Perhaps they are laughing at us humans, racing in a dozen directions yet each one bound to the same destination.

So who is teaching you how to measure your days? Moses asked God. The literal number of our days is short in the light of eternity. Measure them carefully. Begin, like Moses, with God.


