# **Finally**

"Finally, brethren, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as it did also with you;" (2 Thessalonians 3:1 NAU)

When I say 'finally,' it probably doesn't mean a whole lot. When Paul writes 'finally,' it means something important. It doesn't mean, "I don't have much left to say." The man wrote Romans. We know he's good for at least sixteen chapters. It means something like, "I am out of time and what I am about to tell you is too important to be left off."

So finally, church family, pray, not as a last resort, but as a first priority. We know it is to be a priority because of what he asked. For he asked nothing less than that the Word of God would speed ahead and be glorified. In the light of a planned meeting to hear the Word of God beginning September 18, we should spend a moment with Paul.

What does he mean by the Word of God speeding ahead? The Greek word is trecho and it is easily understood. Some of you drive an F-150 trecho and some of you drive a Silverado trecho. It is very likely that both of you think that your trecho can out-trecho the other's trecho. The English word 'trek' comes closer to it, but you get the picture. Paul wanted the church to pray that the Word of God would 'keep on trucking.'

If you read on from 3:1, you will see that there were obstacles to this trek of the Word of God. Paul was looking for deliverance from those obstacles so that the mission could move on. As it turned out, the obstacles were people. And back of those people were powers that even those people likely didn't understand. Nevertheless, Paul wanted the church to faithfully present these matters to the only one who could do anything about it. Finally, brethren, pray.

What does it mean for the Word of God to be glorified? Paul wanted the Word to be honored, to be held high, and to have prominence before the church and a lost world. Paul was the one who wrote "the gospel ... is the power of God unto salvation" (Romans 1:16). Satan must indeed fear the proclamation of the Gospel. His household has been plundered (Mark 3:26-27) again and again by the strong man, Jesus. I am proof and so are you if you believe in him unto salvation. Who can he not save if he wills to do so? The saving belongs to God. The telling belongs to us. Let the Word be glorified.

I urge you to put Paul's command into motion. For, finally, it comes not from Paul but from God. The men who are coming to share God's Word with us all love the Lord, love his Word, and desire to be faithful to it. Pray for them. But the more urgent call is to pray for one another. For why would God send a word at all if we are not predisposed to embrace it in faith?

Several of these men have asked me if there is a theme for the meeting. I told them no. If God chooses for us to hear the same message five times in a row, perhaps it will get our attention.

Finally, brethren, pray . . .






# **Canned Vegetables**

# Fall Sudoku


