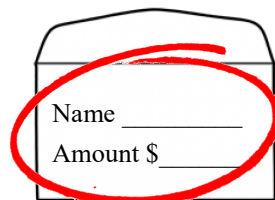

A total of 36 units of blood were given within the first 24 hours of his accident. After a 23 day fight to live, Chase succumbed to his injuries on November 9, 2021. 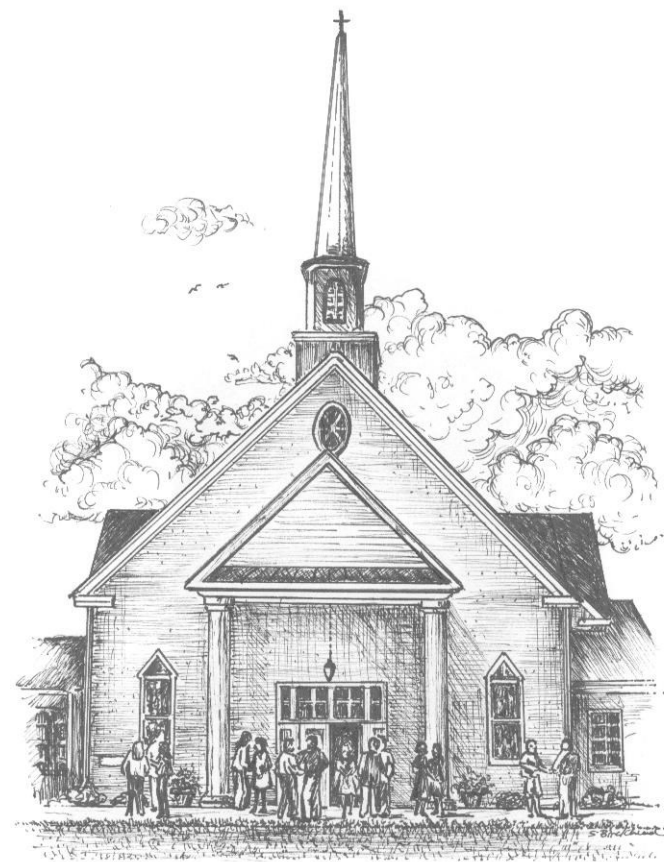
