Join us for a **Thanksgiving Service** and Soup & Sandwich Meal on Wednesday, November 23rd at 6:30 PM in the Gvm.



As of 11/13/22, a copy of the Proposed 2023 Operating Budget has been made available by the Finance Committee for your review and consideration. Note that a motion from the Deacons regarding a delay in some hiring activities is attached to the budget copy - approval of this motion would result in a change in the final total budget amount that is proposed for 2023. This motion and budget draft will be presented for discussion at 4th Quarter Church Conference on Wednesday 11/30. The Final Operating Budget will be voted on after Worship on Sunday 12/4. Please be in prayer as we prepare together for 2023!

The following items will be placed into business for consideration at the November 30th Church Conference.

#### . Personnel Committee Job Description Revision

The Deacons in consultation with the Personnel Committee, recommend the following revisions to the Personnel Committee Job Description.

a. Removal of the requirement for the secretary to submit Personnel Committee Meetings Minutes to the Deacons.

b. Pay compensation considerations for all staff and fee-for-service employees be a joint decision between the Personnel Committee and the Finance Committee. (Senior Pastor pay compensation considerations will be the responsibility of the Deacons.)

c. Removal of staff pastors in the nomination process of Personnel Committee Members.

#### 2. Vote Percentage for Calling & Hiring of Pastoral Staff

The Deacons recommend that the following policy be adopted by Rocky Hock Baptist Church: "The calling and hiring of any Pastoral Staff by Rocky Hock Baptist Church will require a positive vote of no less than 80% of the Church membership present and voting at the meeting designated for such purpose."

The following motion came from the November 6th Deacons Meeting and will be discussed at the November 30th Church Conference, along with the Proposed 2023 Budget: In consideration of our fiscal responsibilities, the Deacons recommend the following: The temporary pause of hiring actions for the positions of (a) Associate Pastor of Student Ministries and (b) Director of Family & Children's Ministries until such time that (1) a Senior Pastor is called and (2) a review of the responsibilities and duties of all ministerial/director positions for their alignment with church needs and fiscal feasibility is completed.
