

The **Nominating Committee** would like to revise some of our current committee job descriptions as follows:

1. Recommend merging the Benevolence Committee duties to fall under the Missions Committee.
2. Recommend merging the Bus/Van Committee duties to fall under the Property & Grounds Committee and changing the number of members from nine (9) to seven (7).
3. Recommend the Senior Adults Committee be changed from nine (9) to seven (7) members.
 1. Recommend the Baptism Committee be composed of 4 members serving 2 year terms. Each term would consist of 1 male and 1 female member.
 2. Recommend the Technology Committee be a standing membership committee, eliminating the three-year term.

Additionally, the existing rotation limit of three-year terms will not change (except where noted), but the Nominating Committee will have the authority to ask someone to stay on a committee for an additional year if they are willing and a vacancy cannot be filled. Updated committee descriptions are available in the vestibule for your review.
