Join us for an Ice Cream Social (ice cream will be provided) beginning at 8 PM, followed by fireworks at approximately 9:15 PM.

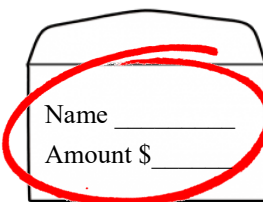
VBS 2023 - Twists and Turns

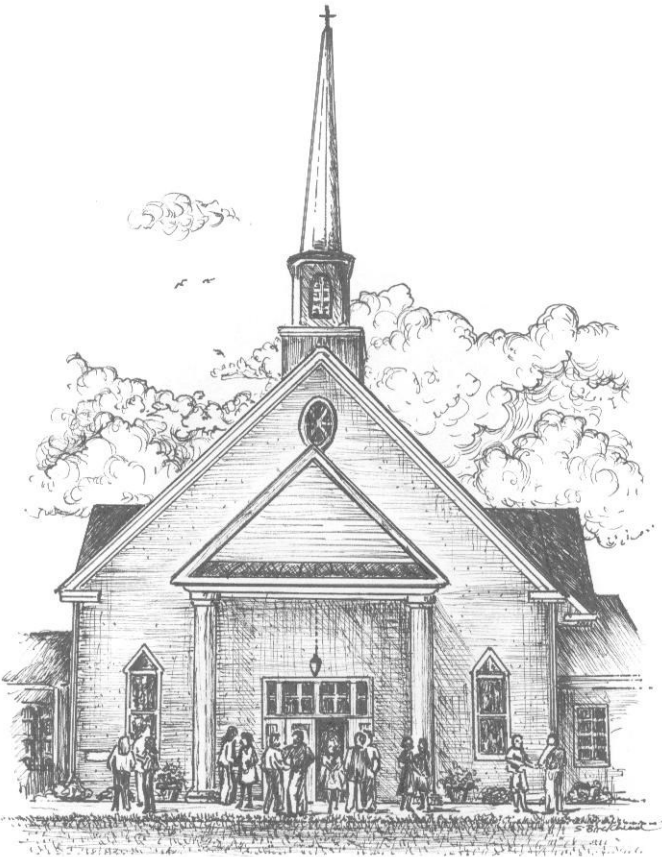
