Leading from the Fruit of the Spirit . . . What Should I Wear?

Do you ever start your day with the age-old question, "What should I wear today?" More than three decades ago, popular speaker and author Esther Burroughs wrote these words for the WMU emphasis book *Empowered*:

Some time ago, I was captivated by the thought in Judges 6:34 of the Spirit of God coming upon Gideon. The Spirit of the Lord "came upon Gideon," which literally means "clothed Gideon." Remember that the angel of the Lord appeared to Gideon on the threshing floor, and Gideon was absolutely terrified and awe-struck because he had great respect for the holiness of God. Literally, the text says, "The spirit of Yahweh 'dressed Himself' with Gideon." The human agent became the outer appearance through which the Spirit worked. As I read this, the truth grabbed my heart. I prayed, "O God, clothe me with Your Spirit." I then envisioned God's Spirit clothing me . . . Think about that! It is awesome! I am clothed with God. I like the idea of God clothing me and wrapping Himself around me, and indeed, He does just that!

In this series, we will explore how to lead from the fruit of the Spirit. We are to be guided and led by the Holy Spirit, our advocate given after Jesus' Crucifixion. God is with us. Our mortal flesh is transformed into a spiritual temple where God dwells on a daily basis. God's one unifying purpose—the spread of the gospel to all nations. When the Holy Spirit comes into our lives, He gives us full access to the fruit of the Spirit outlined in Galatians 5:22-23. Daily ask God to clothe you.

Father, clothe me with Your love.

Father, clothe me with Your joy.

Father, clothe me with Your peace.

Father, clothe me with Your forbearance (patience).

Father, clothe me with Your kindness.

Father, clothe me with Your goodness.

Father, clothe me with Your faithfulness.

Father, clothe me with Your gentleness.

Father, clothe me with Your self-control.

When you are clothed with the fruit of the Spirit, you are more like Christ. When people see you display the fruit of the Spirit, they will be drawn to Christ. Lead from the fruit of the Spirit.


