Who can donate blood? In NC, a person must be at least 16 years old. Under age 18, you must have parental consent and meet height and weight requirements. There is no upper age limit. A person may donate as long as he or she feels well. A person's BP must be between 80/50 and 180/100 at the time of donation, have no fever, and an acceptable iron level. You can donate whole blood every 56 days, up to six times a calendar year. If you donate Power Red or double red cell donation, you can donate



every 112 days, up to three times a calendar year. A Power Red is only for O-neg, O-pos, A-neg, or B-neg. All other exclusions such as medications, health conditions, immunizations, etc. are listed on the Red Cross web site. There are also required pre-donation questions (called RapidPass) that have to be completed the day of the drive. A photo ID or donor card is required, or you can use your Red Cross blood donor app. Please come out to donate blood at this very special blood drive in memory of Chase. Natalie and her family would appreciate your support. You never know when you or your family may need life-saving blood.

The Annie Leary Circle thanks you for your generosity to the **Albemarle Pregnancy Resource Center** during the Baby Bottle campaign. As a church, we donated \$1,731.63 to support their mission in providing counseling and encouraging women to choose life for their unborn child.


