Thursday, November 21st was a great day for RHBC! We accomplished 2 very important outreach ministries. The Partners in Christ Sunday School Class, in coordination with the Albermarle Food Bank, distributed food boxes to 48 seniors in need from the area. The boxes included non-perishables, along with fresh eggs and frozen turkeys. At the same time, our Chase Bateman Memorial Blood Drive, in coordination with the Red Cross, was busy in the Multi-Purpose Room collecting blood from dedicated donors. The emphasis at this drive was the immediate need for blood during the treatment of trauma victims. We saw donors from several counties. We collected 26 whole blood products and 10 Power Red Products. Each time a Power Red Donation is done, it yields 2 products. That made a total of 36 blood products collected, which surpassed our goal. Just 1 donation can save up to 3 lives, equaling up to 108 lives. There were several members who participated in both ministries (Food Distribution and Blood Drive), plus 2 youth participated in the Blood Drive. None of this could have been done without volunteers. Our Senior Food Distribution is every 3rd Tuesday. Our Blood Drives are 3 times a year, the next one being March 19th. Thank you to all who participated in these ministries, and especially the donors who gave blood to help save lives. ~ Rhonda Bass
