




CentriFuge for Youth is June 10th - 14th.

Hosted by Baptists on Mission, the rally will highlight the variety of opportunities NC Baptists have to be involved in missions across our state, nation, and world. Featured will be worship, testimonies, mission videos, and a prayer time for missions. These rallies are for anyone who is interested in missions. A main focus of these rallies will be state, national, international partnerships and projects (i.e., Disaster Relief) and the NC Missions Offering.

A meal is provided at no charge, but reservations are necessary to ensure an accurate meal count. The cut off date for reserving a meal is one week **PRIOR** to the event. The meal will begin at 5:45 PM, followed by the program from 6:50 - 8:30 PM.



The next **Building Fund Offering** will be on Sunday, February 25th. It will be taken at the doors at the end of the Morning Worship Service.

RHBC is responsible for feeding the Boys & Girls Club on the 4th Tuesday of each month until school is out. These dates are: February 27th, March 26th, April 23rd, and May 28th. There are 150 children registered in the club, with a normal after-school attendance of 125 - 130. There are two options for feeding them: 1) You can prepare a hot meal and deliver it to the club at 3:00 PM on the appropriate date, or 2) You can bring food the preceding day for their kitchen staff to prepare. Some groups bring hot dogs or hamburgers (to be cooked by the kitchen staff) and buns, along with potato chips, while others bring pizza and a sweet treat or chicken tenders and mac & cheese. A Budget line item has been established to reimburse up to \$150 of the cost.
