FOOD DRIVE

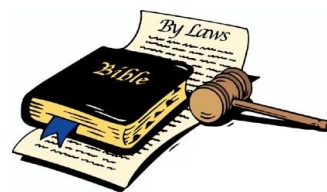

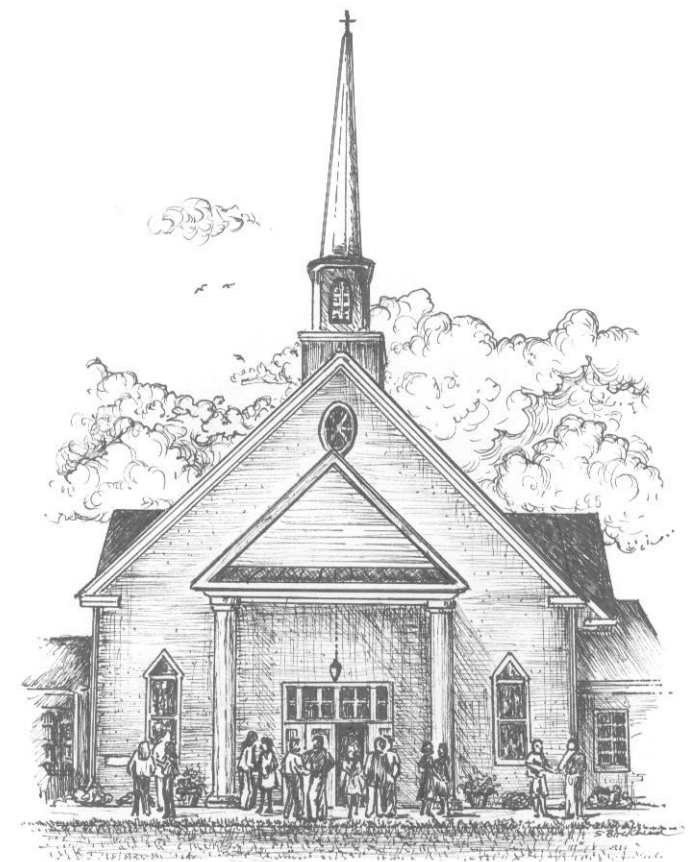
