APRIL FOOD DRIVE



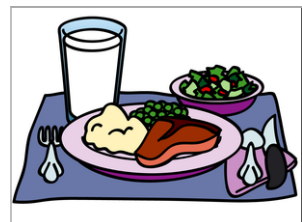

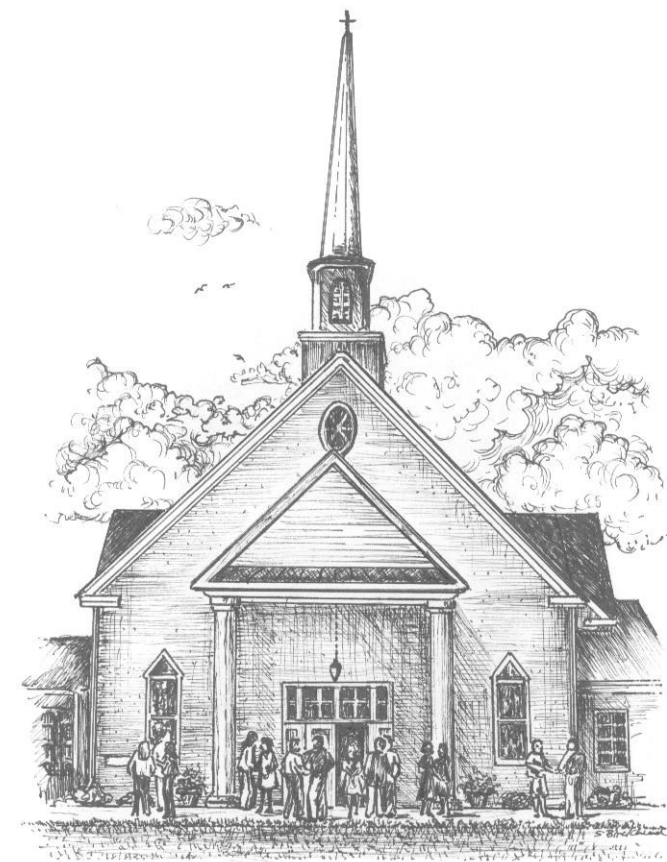
