There will be a **VBS Volunteer Meeting** on Wednesday, May 29th at 6 PM in the Special Function Room. Please see Meredith Tynch for more information.



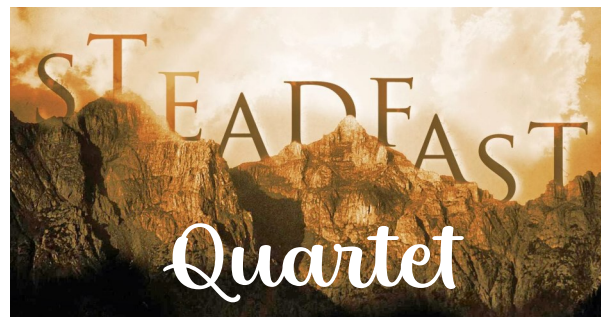
Graduate Sunday is June 2nd! Our 2024 Graduates will be recognized during the 11 AM Worship Service.
