### Children's Back to School Bash



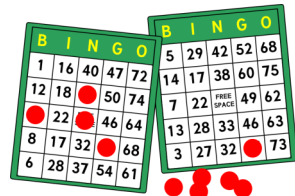

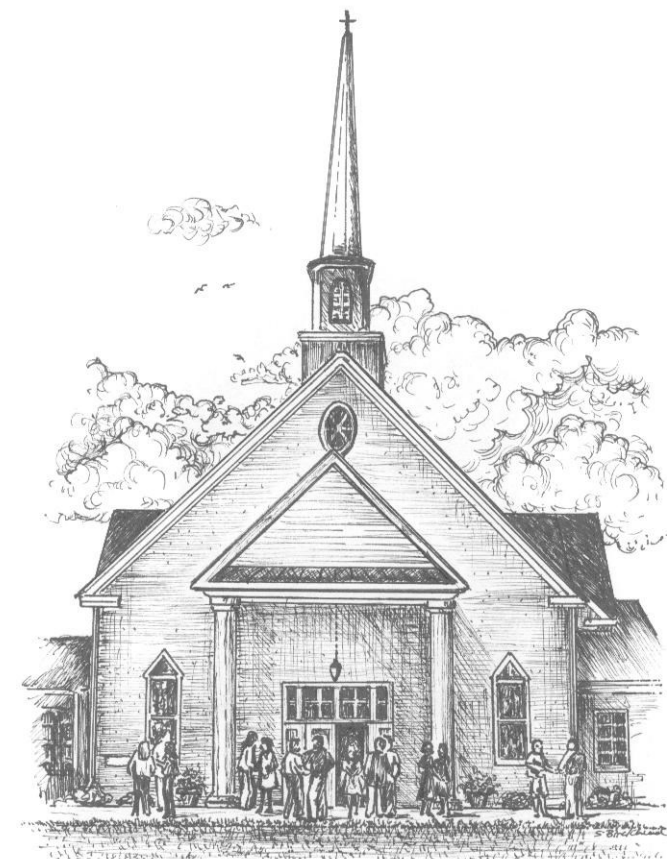
