

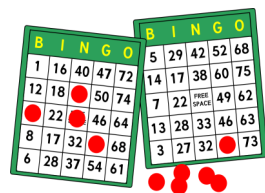

**Please support our current ministry project, "PRAY FOR AMERICA!"**

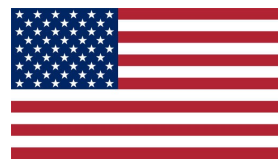

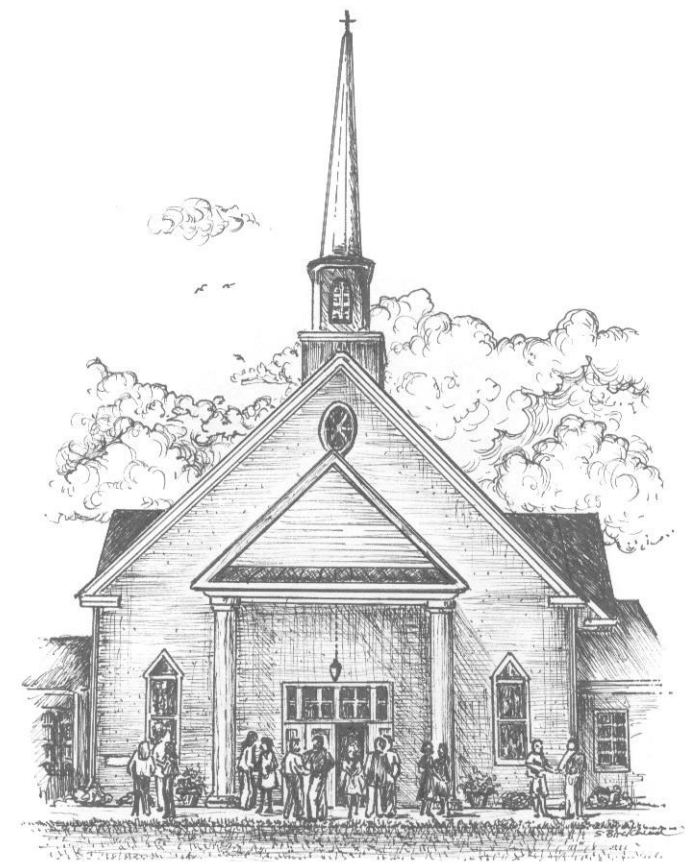
