

Last week I asked, "What is the leading cause of death in teens and young adults?" If you haven't already looked it up, according to the CDC, it's unintentional injury. These kinds of injuries are accidental, such as car accidents, falls, and unfortunately, violence. We want the Chase Bateman Memorial Blood Drive on November 19th to raise awareness of the need for blood when accidents occur and the need is urgent. Chase was only 19 when he received 36 units of blood in the first 48 hours and a total of 64 units over 23 days after he had his ATV accident in 2021. 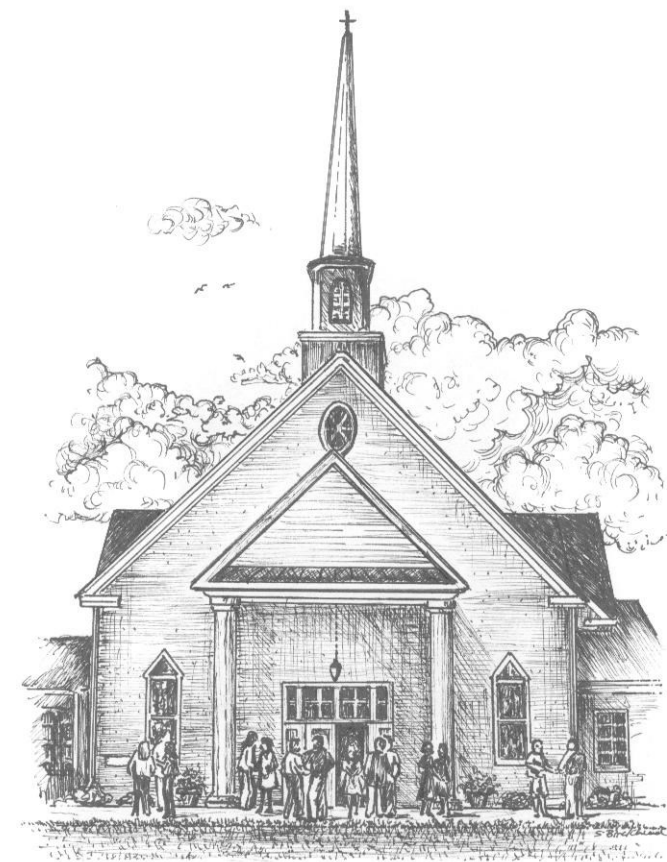
