

Children's Choirs - We are so excited to lead the children in another Christmas program! Last year was such a blessing, and we expect the same with this one!

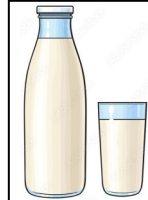

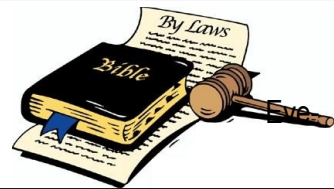


From the Nominating Committee: In preparation for the Quarterly Church Conference on October 30, the following documents are available for review in the vestibule:

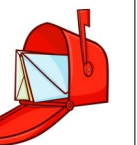

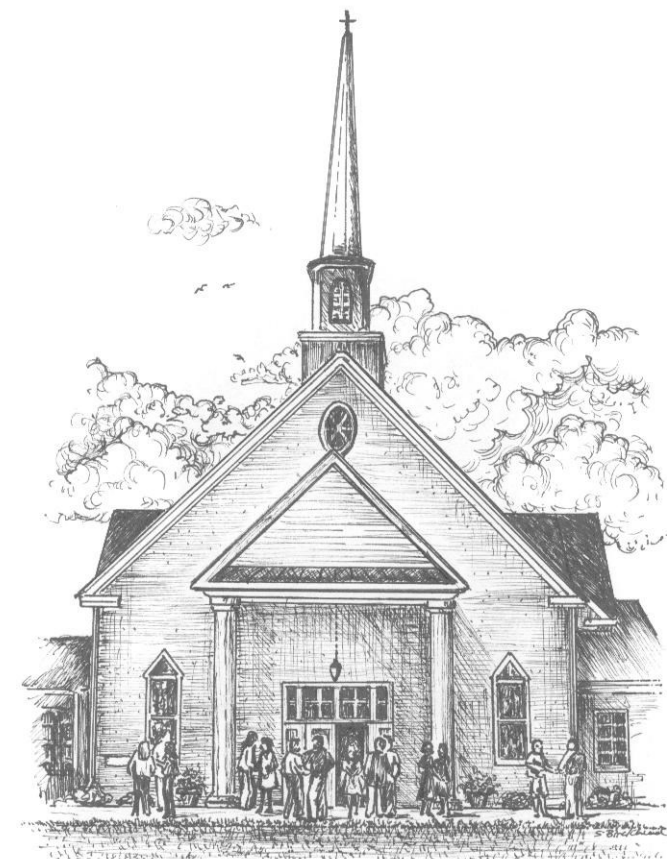
