Chase Bateman Memorial Blood Drive Tuesday, November 19th 1:00 - 6:00 PM in the Multi-Purpose Building

Sometimes we say, "How do I get my money's worth?" Or, "How do I get the most bang for my buck?" Let's switch it to, "How do I help the most people with my blood?" You may qualify for a Power Red Donation. This is a procedure that allows certain donors to give 2 units of red blood cells in a single appointment. It's similar to a



whole blood donation, but a machine separates the red blood cells and returns the plasma and platelets back to the donor. It's become very popular because you're helping more people and the donors don't feel the effects of dehydration as much since you're getting fluid returned back to you. You have to have blood types O+, O-, A-, or B-. Donors can donate every 112 days, up to 3 times a year. There are also other requirements that you can read about on the Red Cross website. Each Power Red donation is equal to donating 2 units of blood. Whichever way you give, or even to volunteer, we would love to have you on November 19th!
