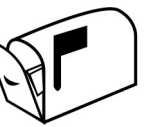
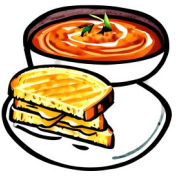
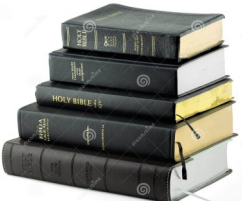
It's that time of year to pack a shoebox for **Operation Christmas Child!** This ministry helps reach children all around the world in the name of Jesus.

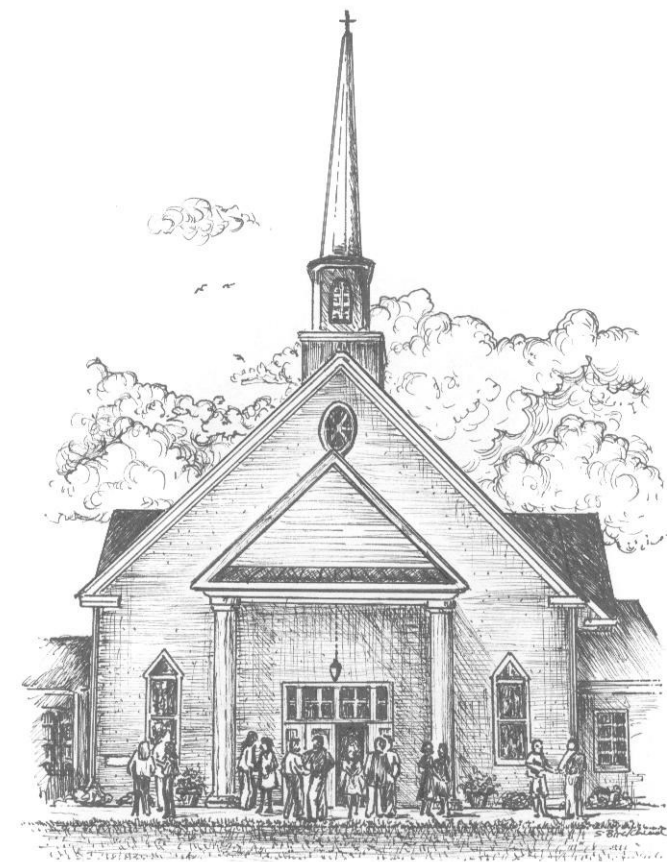
