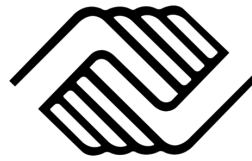

**BOYS & GIRLS CLUB**

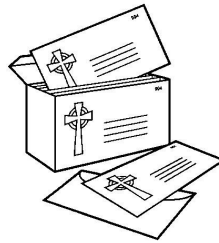
RHBC is responsible for feeding the Boys & Girls Club on the following dates:

**February 25th and May 27th.** There are 150 children registered in the club, with a normal after-school attendance of 125-130.

There are two options for feeding them:

1) You can prepare a hot meal and deliver it to the club at 3 PM on the appropriate date, or 2) You can bring food the preceding day for their kitchen staff to prepare. Some groups bring hot dogs or hamburgers (to be cooked by the kitchen staff) with buns and potato chips, while others bring pizza and a sweet treat or chicken tenders and mac & cheese.
