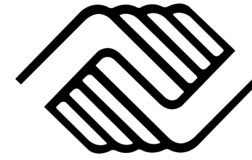
Disaster Relief Training Saturday, February 22nd at Rocky Hock Baptist Church

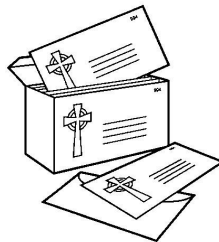

Some groups bring hot dogs or hamburgers (to be cooked by the kitchen staff) with buns and potato chips, while others bring pizza and a sweet treat or chicken tenders and mac & cheese.
