 at Rocky Hock Baptist Church**

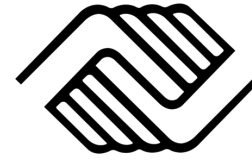

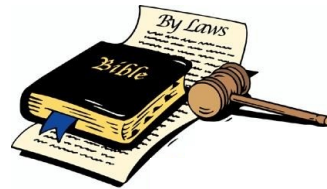


RHBC is responsible for feeding the Boys & Girls Club on the following dates:

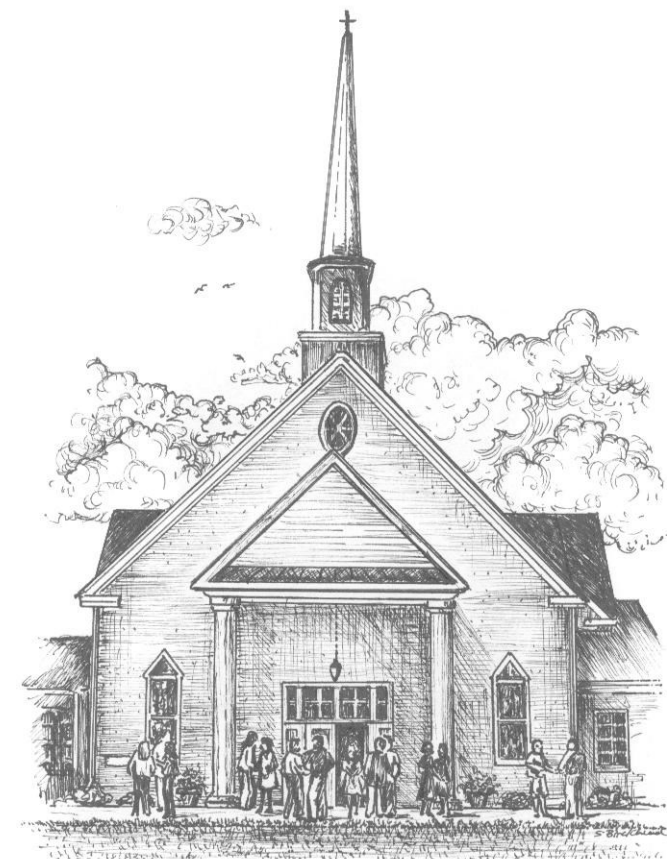
