Did you know that the average adult body has only about 10 units of blood? Losing 15-20% of your blood can cause hypovolemic shock, an extreme emergency. Every 2 seconds, someone in the U.S. needs blood and the most popular blood type is O positive!

Did you know that O negative is considered universal? But what does that mean? There's nothing in their blood for a patient's antibodies to attack and cause a reaction. It can be used for anyone and is often used in emergencies where there is no time to crossmatch blood. One donation at our Blood Drive can save up to 3 lives!

Come donate blood and help our neighbors. Visit redcrossblood.org and enter RHBC to make your appointment.

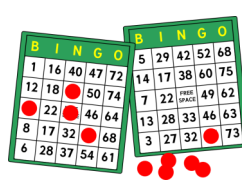

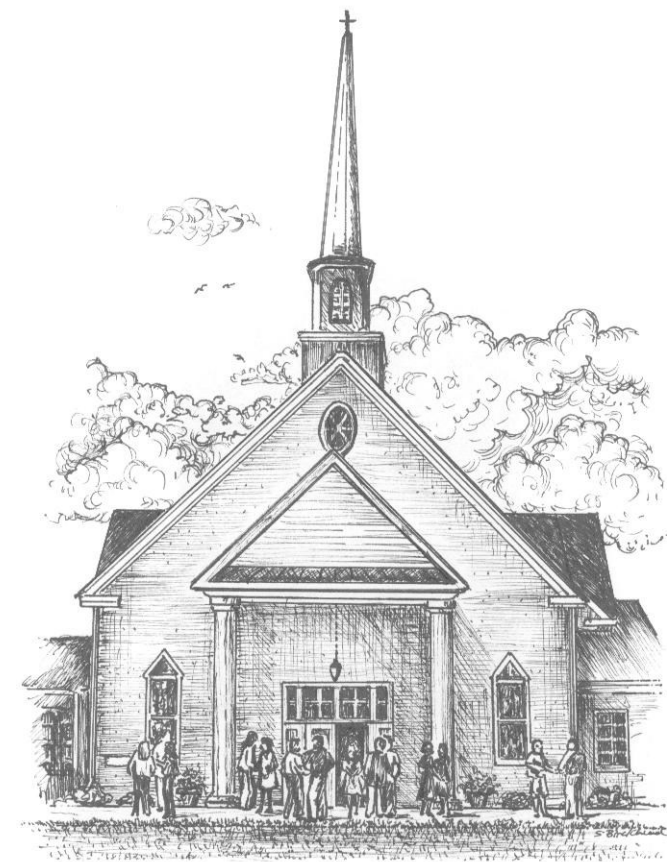
