

Our blood drive is THIS WEEK on Tuesday, March 18th from 1 - 6 PM. Did you know sickle-cell patients have red blood cells that are actually shaped like sickles or crescent moons? This genetic mutation affects the hemoglobin that carries oxygen. These cells clump up in the vessels blocking blood flow and also causes extreme pain. These patients may need transfusions for the rest of their lives.



There are a few things to remember before you come to your appointment on Tuesday. Make sure you complete your Rapid Pass questions that day, preferably before you come in. You can save it to your phone or print it. If you have the blood app on your phone, the questions can be answered there. Make sure you bring your identification to show the staff. That is also on the app. You get a FREE health screening by the staff to make sure you qualify to donate. After that, you can relax on one of the stretchers while you donate your blood.

Did you know your blood is literally liquid gold? It has approximately 0.2 mg of this precious metal! God made us rich right from the beginning! After you donate your rich blood, come have a seat and eat some delicious home-made snacks, absolutely FREE! So if you haven't made your appointment, it's not too late, just go to redcrossblood.org and enter RHBC. Also, fill out one of those crossword puzzles sitting around the church and bring it with you. Answers have been listed in the bulletins. You just might win a prize from Paradise Plant Farm! Our next Blood Drive will be in July, so don't forget!

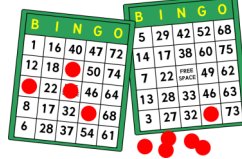


Scripture Stone Painting

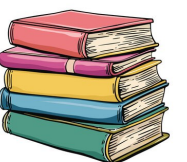

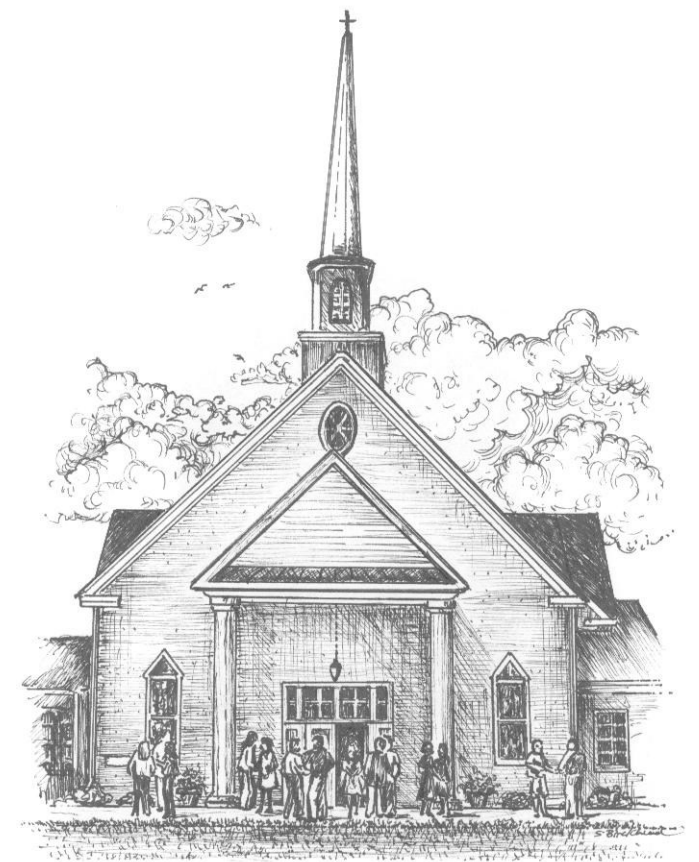
