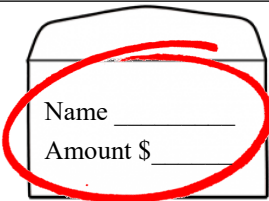

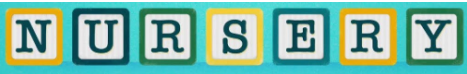
Fuel the Future – Weekend Meals for Kids
