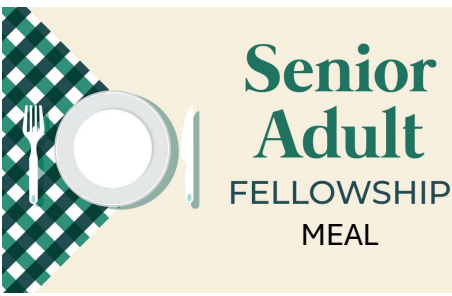
**Children's Back to School Bash**
