Hope everyone is planning to attend and bring your families!

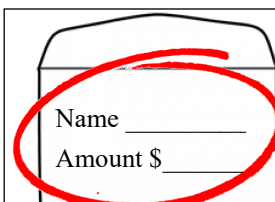


**We will host our Annual Fall Festival on Saturday,
