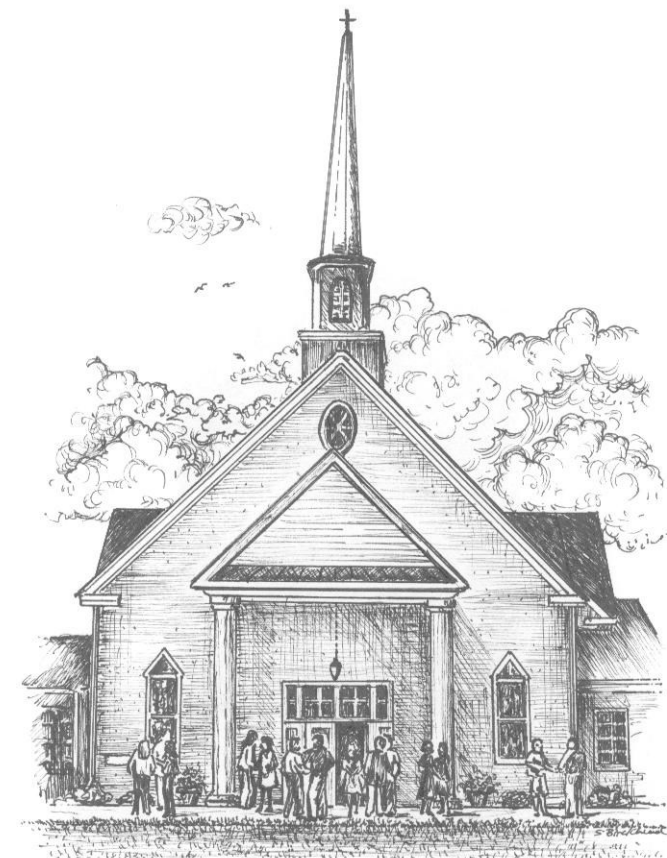
Foster has pastored several churches throughout Western NC and has been privileged to be involved in numerous mission opportunities, both in the States and overseas, as well as several Revival services over the years.
