In order for all of our High School and College Graduates to be recognized, please be sure to contact the church office with your graduation info.

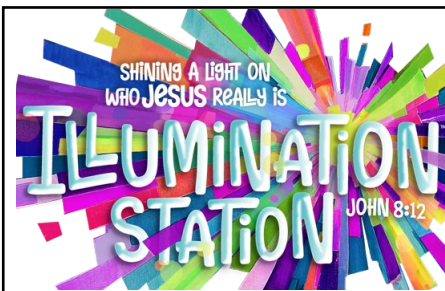

College Graduates should let us know from what College or University they are graduating, along with any honors, as well as the Degree received and in what field.

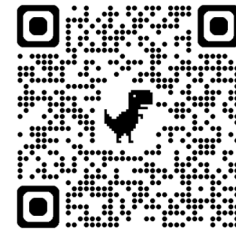
Likewise, if there are any Junior Marshals among our congregation, we'd love to know that, as well!
