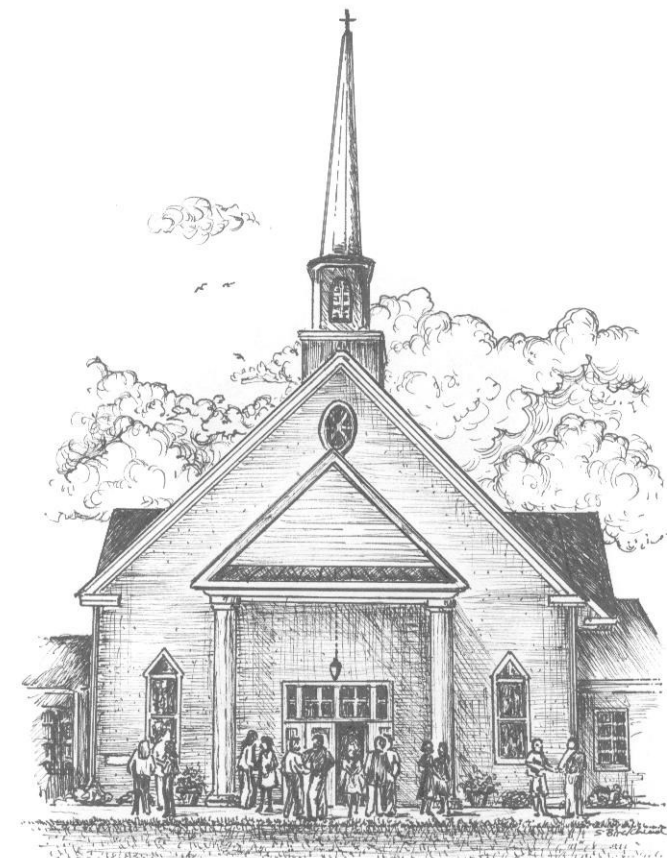
**NO AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES**
