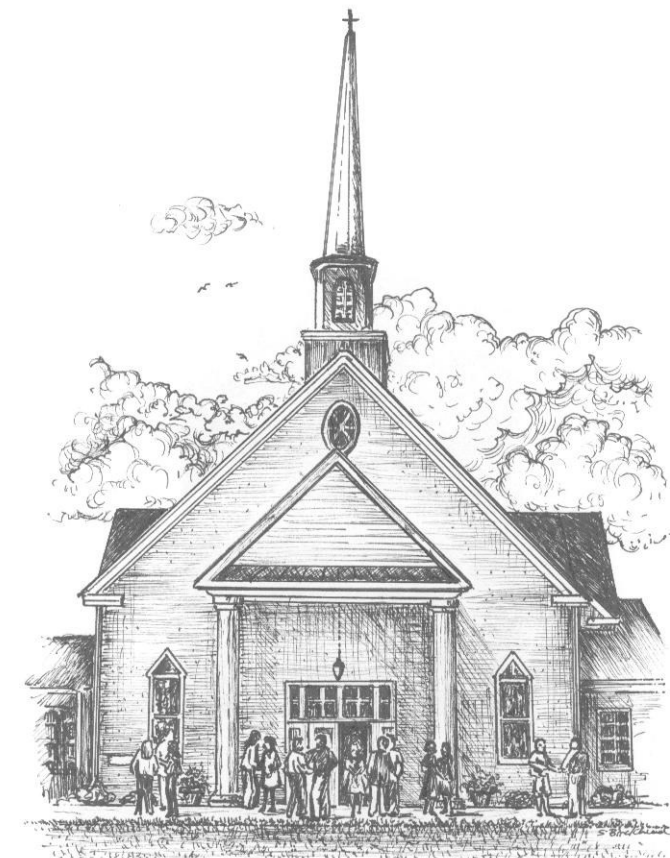

Proposed Child Protection Policy

As part of our ongoing commitment to the safety of our children, a proposed Child Safe Policy has been drafted and is now available for review. You may pick up a copy of the draft at the Church Office, the Multi-Purpose Building Foyer, or in the Vestibule. The primary goal of this policy is to ensure the safety of our children while providing essential protection for the church, its staff, and its members. While specific implementation details will continue to be refined, the administration and oversight of this policy will be handled by a leadership team consisting of the Senior Pastor, Associate Pastor of Student Ministries, Associate Pastor of Worship & Discipleship, Director of Family & Children's Ministries, VBS Director, and Chairman of Deacons. **We encourage all members to prayerfully review the document and join us for discussion during the Church Conference on Wednesday, May 27th. Following this discussion, we will hold a ballot vote on Sunday, May 31st to officially adopt the policy.** Thank you for helping to keep our church a safe and welcoming place for every family.
